**FOOD PROCESSING UNIT IN JABALPUR**

**1349. SHRI VIVEK K. TANKHA:**

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by Government to install and promote food processing unit in the region comprising of Jabalpur, Narsinghpur, Gadarwara, Katni, Rewa, Shahdol and surrounding regions in view of the fact that the entire belt is a rich agricultural belt with potential for food processing unit;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government is considering implementing Mega Food Park scheme in this region, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reason therefor?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES  
(SHRI CHIRAG PASWAN)

(a) to (c). The Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY) was envisaged as a comprehensive package which will result in creation of modern infrastructure with efficient supply chain management from farm gate to retail outlet. It will not only provide a big boost to the growth of food processing sector in the country but also help in providing better returns to farmers and is a big step towards increasing farmers income, creating employment opportunities especially in the rural areas, reducing wastage of agricultural produce, increasing the processing level and enhancing the export of the processed foods.

Under the component scheme for Mega Food Parks (MFPs) under PMKSY, total 41 projects have been approved in the country. Out of these, 02 Mega Food Parks projects have been approved in the district of Khargaoon and Dewas in Madhya Pradesh.

Further, the Mega Food Park (MFP) scheme has been discontinued by the Government with effect from 01.04.2021 with provision for committed liabilities for ongoing projects. Since, the scheme is discontinued, hence, setting up of new Mega Food Park cannot be supported anywhere in the country.
