INDIAN INSTITUTE OF HANDLOOM TECHNOLOGY AT FULIA

1433. SHRI SAMIK BHATTACHARYA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) the reasons for the Indian Institute of Handloom Technology in Fulia, West Bengal has not started any undergraduate or postgraduate courses even after ten years of its establishment;
- (b) the specific challenges that have prevented the initiation of undergraduate and postgraduate programs at IIHT in Fulia, and steps being taken to address these issues; and
- (c) whether Government is monitoring the institute's progress and performance?
