PROJECTS COMPLETED UNDER SCM

1494. SHRI JOSE K. MANI

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details regarding the status of completion of projects under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) and the reasons for any delay;
- (b) the details regarding the quantum of funds released under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) over the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government has any plans to extend the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) by including additional cities under its ambit; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

- (a) As per the data provided by 100 Smart Cities, as of 12th July, 2024, a total of 7,218 projects amounting to ₹1,45,083 crore (90%) have been completed under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM). As apprised by Smart Cities, the delay in completion of projects can be attributed to varying reasons including, *inter alia*, legal issues, delay in obtaining clearances from different departments, land acquisition, construction in hilly areas, challenges in vendor and resource availability in small & medium cities.
- (b) As on 12th July, 2024, out of funds of ₹48,000 crore earmarked for projects under SCM, an amount of ₹46,676 crore have been released to cities under SCM, of which ₹43,354 crore (93%) has been utilised. In the last 3 financial years, i.e., FY 2022-23, FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25, the Central Government has released ₹17,134 crore. The State-wise details is at Annexure.
- (c) & (d) The mission period for completing the implementation of ongoing SCM projects has been extended upto 31st March, 2025. At present, there is no proposal under consideration of the Central Government to extend SCM by including additional cities.
