STATUS OF WATER AND SEWER CONNECTIONS UNDER AMRUT IN RAJASTHAN

1504. SHRI NEERAJ DANGI

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of areas of States added under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) during the last two years, district-wise;
- (b) the status of water and sewerage connections under AMRUT in the State of Rajasthan during the said period, State/Region-wise; and
- (c) the total number of State Annual Action Plan approved and completed in the State of Rajasthan under AMRUT Mission by Government during the last two years and the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS
(SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on 25 June 2015 in selected 500 cities and towns across the country. All Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) with a population of one lakh or more as per Census 2011, all other capital cities of States/ Union Territories (UTs), all Heritage Cities under the Heritage City Development & Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY), identified cities on the stem of the main rivers, 10 cities from hill states, islands and tourist destinations (not more than one from each State) have been taken up under AMRUT. List of cities is attached at **ANNEXURE-I**.

(b): As reported by the State Government, under AMRUT Mission, 4.45 lakh water tap connections have been provided through AMRUT & in convergence with other schemes & 6.15 lakh sewer connections (including households covered through Faecal Sludge and Septage Management) have been provided through AMRUT & in convergence with other schemes in Rajasthan. State wise details are attached at **ANNEXURE-II**.

(c): Under AMRUT, State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) worth ₹3,224 crore were approved in the Financial Years 2015-16 (SAAP-I), 2016-17 (SAAP-II) and 2017-20 (SAAP-III) for the State of Rajasthan.

Against the approved SAAP, Government of Rajasthan has grounded 144 projects worth ₹3,548.32 crore of which 120 projects worth ₹2,032.06 crore have been completed. Further, total works worth ₹3,453.99 crore have been physically executed and total expenditure worth ₹3,101.67 crore has been incurred.
