Oil and Gas Infrastructure Projects in Karnataka

1575. Dr. Dharmasthala Veerendra Heggade:

Will the Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of progress of various ongoing projects of Government for better petroleum, oil and natural gas related infrastructure, costing ₹ 100 crore and above in Karnataka, the details of district-wise progress in Karnataka and the main reasons for inadequate pace of implementation;
- (b) the estimate of livelihood opportunities made available through new infrastructure projects implemented in the State of Karnataka after May, 2019;
- (c) the comparative figures of amount spent on petroleum, oil and natural gas related Projects implemented in Karnataka between 2019-2024; and
- (d) the present status of construction of 80000 MT LPG Cavern at Mangalore?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS

- (a): Details of progress of various ongoing projects of Oil and Gas Public Sector Undertakings /JVs costing ₹ 100 crore and above in the districts of the State of Karnataka or passing through Karnataka are at Annexure-I. As reported by the project implementing agencies, the major reasons for delays in certain projects inter-alia include delay in (i) land/Right of Use acquisition, (ii) environment, forest and wildlife clearances, and (iii) contractual issues.
- (b): The number of livelihood opportunities made available through new infrastructure projects implemented in the State of Karnataka or passing through Karnataka after May, 2019 are estimated to be over 17 lakh mandays.
- (c): The amount spent on petroleum, oil & natural gas related projects implemented in the State of Karnataka or passing through Karnataka in 2018-19 was ₹ 582 crore and in 2023-24 was ₹ 808 crore.
- (d): HPCL is executing Construction of 80,000 MT LPG Cavern at Mangalore, with total project cost of ₹ 854 crore. This project is at advanced stage of completion with physical progress of 86%.
