**PROVIDING THE CTI/MRI TEST FACILITY IN NEW GOVERNMENT MEDICAL  
COLLEGES**

**1703. DR. KANIMOZHI NVN SOMU:**

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether steps have been taken for providing the CTI/MRI test facility for the benefit of patients in new Government medical colleges where such test facilities are not available;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has any proposal for providing 'Linear Accelerator device' in Government Medical colleges in order to provide better medical treatment facility to cancer patients;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, district-wise; and
- (e) by when a final decision in this regard is likely to be taken?

**ANSWER

(a) to (e): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for 'Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college. The fund sharing mechanism between the Centre and State Governments is in the ratio of 90:10 for North Eastern and Special Category States, and 60:40 for others. Under the Scheme, financial support is provided for development of infrastructure and procurement of equipment.

This Ministry is also implementing another CSS namely 'Strengthening of Tertiary Care

Cancer Centre facility Scheme to enhance the facilities for tertiary care of Cancer under National Programme for Prevention & Control of Non-Communicable Diseases (NP-NCD)'. Under the Scheme financial assistance upto ₹120 crore for State Cancer Institute (SCI) and upto ₹45 crore for Tertiary Cancer Care Centre (TCCC) is provided. The financial assistance is provided for procurement of radiotherapy equipment including Linear Accelerator device, diagnostic equipment, surgical equipment, enhancement of indoor civil work and patient facility for Cancer and such other purposes relevant for diagnosis, treatment and care of Cancer. Details of 19-SCIs and 20-TCCCs, approved under the scheme, which includes 17 Medical Colleges are at Annexure.
