FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO TRIBAL STUDENTS

1844 # DR. SUMER SINGH SOLANKI:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government provides any financial aid to private schools imparting education to tribal students;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of such institutions in the State of Madhya Pradesh; and
- (c) whether Government also monitors that the culture, heritage, mother tongue of the tribal community are being maintained and preserved by the said institutions, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Ministry of Tribal Affairs is implementing a scheme “Grants-in-Aid to Voluntary Organizations (VOs) working for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes” under which grants are provided to NGOs/VOs working in health, education & livelihood sectors. The funds are release to the NGOS/VOs for the above mentioned interventions as per the guidelines and norms issued by the Ministry on 27th Januray 2023. Further details can be viewed on Ministry's web site (tribal.nic.in). The details of NGOs/ VOs in Madhya Pradesh funded by the Ministry during last 3 years is as per **Annexure-I**.

The Institutes to whom grants are given by Ministry are recommended by the State Government after verification by district authorities, who submit a report through online portal (ngo.tribal.gov.in). It is also mandatory for these NGOs to get themselves registered on the NITI Darpan Portal.

Apart from this, as informed by the State Government, Madhya Pradesh State also provides financial aid to NGO run schools, Ashram Shalas and Balwadis. The number of such institutions in the State of Madhya Pradesh is 107. The State Government also undertakes regular monitoring of these NGOs through field officers.
