PM-AJAY SCHEME

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Schemes namely, Adarsh Gram, Special Central Assistance to Scheduled Castes Sub Plan and Babu Jagjivan Ram Chhatrawas Yojana have been merged into Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abhyuday Yojana (PM-AJAY);
- (b) if so, the progress made under the revised scheme in its various components and the funds allocated and utilised, year-wise;
- (c) whether Government has any plans to revise the criteria fixed for selecting villages under “Adarsh Gram”; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abhyuday Yojana (PM-AJAY), a Centrally Sponsored Scheme was launched in 2021-22 by merging three existing schemes namely Adarsh Gram, Special Central Assistance to Scheduled Castes Sub Plan and Babu Jagjivan Ram Chhatrawas Yojana.
- (b) The progress made under Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abhyuday Yojana (PM-AJAY) component wise during last three years is at Annexure.
- (c) & (d) At present there is no proposal under consideration under the Adarsh Gram component of PM-AJAY regarding revising the criteria for selection of villages.
