**ALLOCATION AND UTILIZATION OF FUNDS UNDER PM-AASHA**

\*197. SHRI RANDEEP SINGH SURJEWALA :

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated and utilised under Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay SanraksHan Abhiyan (PM AASHA) Scheme since 2021, year-wise, State-wise; and
- (b) the details of the instances of compensation provided to pulses and oilseeds crops since 2021, year-wise, State-wise?

**STATEMENT IN RESPECT OF PARTS (a) & (b) OF THE RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 197 FOR 09/08/2024 REGARDING ALLOCATION AND UTILIZATION OF FUNDS UNDER PM-AASHA.**

(a) : Government implements Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay SanraksHan Abhiyan (PM-AASHA) comprising of Price Support Scheme (PSS), Price Deficit Payment Scheme (PDPS) and pilot of Private Procurement and Stockist Scheme (PPSS) for providing Minimum Support Price (MSP) of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) of notified pulses, oilseeds and copra directly to pre-registered farmers as and when market price of these produce fall below the MSP during the harvesting period, in consultation with the concerned State Government / Union Territory, as per prescribed guidelines. PSS is implemented for procurement of oilseeds, pulses and copra. For oilseeds, States/UTs have options to choose either PSS or PDPS in a given procurement season with respect to a particular oilseed crop for the entire State. PDPS envisages direct payment of the difference between the MSP and the selling / modal price within the stipulated period in the notified market yard through a transparent auction process. PPSS is implemented for oilseeds on pilot basis and States/UTs have the option for implementation of PPSS in district/selected Agricultural Produce Market Committees (APMCs) of district involving the participation of private stockist.

Central Government has provided Government Guarantee amounting to Rs. 40,500/- crore to lender banks for extending cash credit facilities by Central Nodal Agencies (CNA) like National Agricultural Co-operative Marketing Federation of India Limited (NAFED), National Co-operative Consumer's Federation of India Limited (NCCF) etc. for undertaking procurement operations at MSP under PSS. CNAs withdraw the required funds against the Government Guarantee for making payment of MSP value to farmers and other incidental costs involved in the procurement operations.

Further, the annual budgetary provision under the scheme is made for reimbursement of losses incurred in implementation of the scheme as per requirement. The indicative budgetary estimates are based on previous years demand of the schemes and gets revised based on the actual requirements. Under PM-AASHA, funds are not allocated to States / UTs, instead, funds are reimbursed to CNAs towards losses incurred in implementation of the scheme for further depositing into Cash Credit Accounts.
