- (a) whether Government has formulated any special scheme for the documentation and preservation of traditional medicinal knowledge of Thakar tribe of Raigad district;
- (b) the steps being taken to integrate this knowledge into the formal health system so that it can be used on a larger scale; and
- (c) whether any research programme has been launched or a research centre has been set up to preserve the traditional knowledge of Thakar tribe and other communities?

(c): The Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS) has implemented “Tribal Health Care Research Programme (THCRP)” under Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) for the welfare of the tribal people. Through this programme council is creating awareness about Health, Nutrition, and Hygiene among Scheduled Tribe (ST) community, providing health care services and incidental medical care, and documenting demographic trends through door to door survey. Local Health Traditions (LHT) and folklore practices among tribal population have also been documented in this programme. This programme is being executed through 14 CCRAS Institutes in identified ST dominant Villages/Blocks of 14 States and Ethno- medical Botanical Practices and Survey are carried out by 15 peripheral institutes of the CCRAS.
