Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any plans to establish dedicated sports injury centers in medical colleges in District Bhiwani to address the growing number of sports-related injuries;
- (b) if so, the details of such plans, including the number of medical colleges selected for setting up sports injury centers along with their locations and the expected timeline for implementation especially in Haryana;
- (c) the steps being taken to train medical professionals, including doctors, physiotherapists and sports medicine specialists, in treating sports-related injuries at these centers; and
- (d) whether any collaboration has been made with national and international sports organizations?
