VACCINATIONS UNDER MISSION INDRADHANUSH

- (a) the features of the Mission Indradhanush Programme launched by Government;
- (b) the total number of types of vaccinations provided under this Programme;
- (c) the number of people in the country who have benefited from this Programme so far;
- (d) the total number of beneficiaries in Uttar Pradesh who have benefited from this scheme; and
- (e) the details of the positive aspects of this scheme?

- (a) Mission Indradhanush is a special catch-up vaccination campaign under the Universal Immunization Programme, conducted in areas of low immunization coverage to vaccinate left out and dropped out children and pregnant women.
- (b) 11 types of vaccines, which are used in Universal Immunization Programme, are provided in this programme.
- (c) A total of 5.46 crore children and 1.32 crore pregnant women have been vaccinated in all phases of Mission Indradhanush conducted so far in the country.
- (d) A total of 1.79 crore children and 45.13 lakh pregnant women have been vaccinated in this programme in Uttar Pradesh.
- (e) Mission Indradhanush has increased the vaccine coverage under National Universal Immunization Programme.
