**SHOWCASING ODISHA'S RICH HERITAGE

2737. Shri Debashish Samantaray:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether Government has organized any cultural exchange programmes to showcase Odisha's rich heritage, such as Odissi dance, Pattachitra art, and tribal culture on international platforms;
- (b) The number of such events held in the last three years and their impact on global recognition of Odisha's culture; and
- (c) The future plans to expand cultural diplomacy initiatives involving Odisha?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Ministry of Culture implements "Global Engagement Scheme" to promote India's rich cultural heritage and enhance India's image in the global arena in a concerted manner. Under the Scheme, the Festival of India (Fol) is organized abroad to promote people to people connect and bilateral cultural contacts. The artists, including the artists from Odisha, from diverse cultural fields such as Folk Art including Folk Music, Folk Dance, Folk Theatre & Puppetry, Classical and Traditional Dance, Experimental/ Contemporary Dance, Classical/ Semi Classical Music, Theatre etc. perform in the 'Festivals of India' abroad.

The Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), an autonomous organization under Ministry of External Affairs, promotes Indian culture worldwide including Odisha's culture, through its Cultural Centres and Missions/Posts abroad.

The details of events held by ICCR during the last three years for global recognition of Odisha's culture are given at **Annexure I**. The events organized help to popularize and create interest about Indian art & culture and foster closer friendship between India and other countries.

(c) ICCR has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the State Government of Odisha on 27 September 2024 to promote Odisha's culture abroad.
