'GO INDIA SMART CARD' PROJECT

- (a) whether the 'Go India Smart Card' project to facilitate single window package for the passenger to seamlessly pay for tickets for long distance, suburban, metro journeys, has been launched;

- (a) to (c) With a view to facilitate passengers to pay seamlessly for tickets, it has been decided to conduct a Proof of Concept of inter operable open loop National Common Mobility Card (NCMC) based on the guidelines of MOHUA (Ministry Of Housing and Urban Affairs). Accordingly, Indian Railways and State Bank of India have signed a Memorandum of Understanding for conducting Proof of Concept at two stations of Mumbai Suburban areas.
