**IPDS TO SUPPORT TEXTILE PROCESSING CLUSTERS**

3034. SHRI NARAYANA KORAGAPPA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Integrated Processing Development Scheme (IPDS) supports the existing textile processing clusters in the area of water and waste water management;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of projects implemented under the scheme, State-wise; and
- (d) the details of the financial incentives, subsidies under the scheme?

**ANSWER**

**(a) to (d):** In order to facilitate the textile industry to meet the required environmental standards and to support new Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETP)/ upgradation of CETPs in processing clusters/ processing parks, the Government is implementing Integrated Processing Development Scheme (IPDS) since 2013. The scheme aims to facilitate the Indian textile industry to become globally competitive using environmentally friendly processing standards and technology. The scheme would also be applicable for technology upgradation and capacity enhancement in existing Textile Clusters.

Under the Scheme, grant upto 50% of the project cost but not exceeding Rs.75 crore for CETPs with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) and Marine discharge and Rs.10 crore for riverine and conventional treatment is provided to eligible projects.

Under the Scheme, 6 projects have been sanctioned which are under implementation. State wise details of projects are as follows:
