**KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS AND JAWAHAR NAVODAYA
VIDYALAYAS IN PUNJAB**

1780 SHRI VIKRAMJIT SINGH SAHNEY:

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the existing functional Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas in the State of Punjab with total students and total teachers, district-wise, school-wise;
- (b) whether Government have sanctioned any new KVs or Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas in the State of Punjab in last five years;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of the construction of sanctioned school infrastructure and timeline of their completion; and
- (e) the details of the per meal cost of meal served to the residential students of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas?

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION
(SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)**

- (a) At present, 52 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) and 23 Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) are functioning in the State of Punjab. The district-wise and school-wise details along with the details of total students and total teachers, in respect of these KVs and JNVs are at Annexure-I & II respectively.
- (b) to (c) As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), 02 KVs namely IIT Ropar, District Roopnagar and Central University of Punjab, Ghudda, District Bathinda have been sanctioned and made functional in the State of Punjab in last five years.

The Navodaya Vidyalaya Scheme envisages opening of one Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) in each district of the country. All the districts (as on 31.05.2014) of the States/UTs including the State of Punjab which have accepted the scheme, other than 6 districts with 100% urban population, have been covered under the scheme.

(d) Out of 52 KVs functioning in the State of Punjab, 40 KVs are functioning in permanent school buildings. For remaining 12 KVs, school buildings are at construction stage in respect of 11 KVs and for 01 KV land is yet to be provided by the concerned sponsoring authority in favour of KVS, as per norms. Construction of permanent buildings for KVs is a continuous process, which depends upon identification of suitable land, completion of lease formalities in favour of KVS by the sponsoring authorities, submission of drawings / estimates by construction agency, availability of funds and requisite approvals etc.

As per information received from Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS), all the 23 JNVs in the State of Punjab are functioning from permanent site.

(e) The norms for mess expenditure in JNVs for its students are as under:

1	JNVs located at other than hard and difficult areas	Rs. 2240.00 per student per month (Rs. 74.67 per student per day)
2	JNVs located at hard and difficult areas	Rs. 2546.00 per student per month (Rs. 84.87 per student per day)
3	JNVs located at Extreme hard and difficult station	Rs. 2672.00 per student per month (Rs. 89.07 per student per day).
