- (a) the total number of highway projects sanctioned for the State of Madhya Pradesh and the total length of highways;
- (b) the impact these projects will have on connectivity in sectors that drive economic growth; and
- (c) the progress of ongoing highway projects in the State and their role in shaping the lives of citizens?

(a) to (c) Total 105 works costing Rs. 44,819 Crores and aggregating 3,148 km total length have been sanctioned for up-gradation and development of National Highways (NHs) in the State of Madhya Pradesh in the last three years including current year. Total 2,665 km length of NHs has been constructed in the State in the last three years including current year. The construction of these NH development projects will ensure smooth flow of both inter-state as well as intra-state traffic with better connectivity boosting the overall economic growth of the State. This will also ensure reduction in the travel time and vehicle operation cost with increased safety of the road users.
