**FUNDS FOR ROAD SAFETY**

1850. SHRI BABUBHAI JESANGBHAI DESAI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether any allocation of funds are sanctioned for road safety by Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the amount of funds allocated to States for improving road safety in their respective States; and
- (d) the details thereof, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) to (d) Road Safety is an integral and indispensable component of every National Highways Project. Road Safety initiatives commence with the inception of Detailed Project report as road safety audit has been made mandatory at all stages i.e. design, construction, operation & maintenance through third party auditors/experts. As per available data, funds allocated to be spent for comprehensive road safety aspects varies from 2.21 % to 15 % of total cost of the development projects depending upon structures involved for construction of National Highways.

Besides, the Central Government also implements schemes for creation of awareness among road users, financial assistance for setting up of Model Driving Training Institutes/Centres and Inspection & Certification Centres in States/UTs, improving and Strengthening of Public Transport System etc. These are nationwide Central Sector Schemes. The fund allocated under these schemes during the Financial Year 2020-21 to 2024-25 are detailed at Annexure.
