MALNUTRITION AND MORTALITY AMONGST CHILDREN

1910. SHRI SAKET GOKHALE:

Will the Minister of Women and Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the details for malnutrition indicators for children in the age group of 0-5 years which includes proportion of malnutrition, stunting in growth and wasting, State-wise;
- (b) the details of neonatal mortality in children as of October, 2024, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of early childhood mortality (i.e. deaths below 5 years of age) in children as of October 2024, State-wise?

(a) The State wise details of malnutrition indicators for children 0 - 5 years age are at **Annexure-I**.

(b) and (c) The data on neonatal mortality in children and early childhood mortality (i.e. deaths below 5 years of age) is maintained by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. As per the latest available report of Sample Registration System (SRS) 2020 report of Registrar General of India, Neonatal Mortality Rate (NMR) is 20 per 1000 live births and Under 5 Mortality Rate (U5MR) (i.e. deaths below 5 years of age) is 32 per 1000 live births at National level.

The State wise details of neonatal mortality in children are provided at **Annexure – II**.

The State wise details of early childhood mortality (i.e. deaths below 5 years of age) in children are provided at **Annexure – III**.
