(a) to (d) The Ministry of Women & Child Development (MWCD) launched an online emarketing platform namely "Mahila e-Haat" on 07th March 2016, to support and empower women entrepreneurs, Self Help Groups (SHGs) or Non-Governmental Organizational (NGOs).

Government has now promoted platforms such as Government e-Market Place (GeM) as well as e-market place managed by National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) to support the entrepreneurs. In view of this, the Mahila e-Haat has been closed by the Ministry with effect from July, 2020.
