INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT IN TEXTILE SECTOR

637. DR. ASHOK KUMAR MITTAL:

DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of apparel parks, weaving parks and high-tech weaving parks for infrastructure development proposed to be set up across the country, State-wise and district-wise including Punjab and Odisha;
- (b) the total investment in the textile sector so far, State-wise and district-wise, including Punjab and Odisha;
- (c) whether the similar parks are existing in the State of Bihar and Odisha if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the funds allocation across the country for such textile parks and development of such projects, including Punjab and Odisha?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES

(a) to (d): With a view to increasing investments, generating employment opportunities and boosting exports in the textile sector, the Ministry is implementing Scheme for Integrated Textile Park (SITP) to provide support for setting up textile parks with world-class, state-of-the-art infrastructure in textile hubs across the country. The scheme was in implementation upto 31.03.2021; however, the Scheme has now been subsumed under the umbrella Scheme of Textile Cluster Development Scheme (TCDS) (total outlay of TCDS of Rs. 853 crore for completing ongoing projects only). Under SITP, three textile parks were sanctioned in Punjab, details of which are as follows:

No proposal for setting up of Textile Park under SITP in the State of Odisha, Bihar and Punjab is pending in the Ministry.

In addition, the Government has approved setting up of 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of Rs. 4,445 Cr for a period of 2021-22 to 2027-28.

The Government has finalized 7 sites viz. Tamil Nadu (Virudhnagar), Telangana (Warangal), Gujarat (Navsari), Karnataka (Kalaburagi), Madhya Pradesh (Dhar), Uttar Pradesh (Lucknow), Maharashtra (Amravati) for setting up of PM MITRA Parks.

However, information on state-wise/district wise investment in the textile sector is not maintained in the Ministry.
