- (a) The **Ayush Clinical Case Repository Portal** is a digital platform launched by Honourable Minister of Ayush Sh. Sarbananda Sonowal on **May 27, 2021**. The purpose of the portal is to serve as a platform for Ayush practitioners to share and document successful treatment cases across various traditional medicine systems, including Ayurveda, Yoga, Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, Homoeopathy, and Sowa-Rigpa. The main purposes of the portal includes:

Evidence Building: To serve as a repository of well-documented clinical cases that demonstrates the effectiveness of AYUSH interventions in various health conditions.

Knowledge Sharing: To create a platform where practitioners can share their experiences and case outcomes, contributing to collective learning within the Ayush community.

Public Awareness: Providing the public with access to documented cases, thereby increasing awareness of Ayush systems' strengths in treating various ailments.

Research and Analysis: Aggregating clinical outcomes to support further research and analysis, contributing to the scientific validation of Ayush treatments.

COVID-19 Treatment Documentation: Offering a dedicated section for reporting and publishing details of COVID-19 cases treated through Ayush systems, highlighting their role in managing the pandemic.

Transparency and Validation: To promote transparency in documenting AYUSH treatment outcomes and establish credibility by adhering to standardized reporting formats.

- (b) & (c) Public can access this portal through accr.ayush.gov.in and can go through cases published on this portal and can also understand the strengths of various Ayush systems in treatment of various diseases. This Portal aids to strengthen the scientific foundation of Ayush practices and promote informed healthcare choices among the public.
