STATUS OF COASTAL HIGHWAY PROJECT IN ODISHA

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the status of the Coastal Highway project in Odisha, including the length of the highway, key routes, and progress made so far;
- (b) the expected budget and timeline for the completion of the project;
- (c) the expected number of displacement due to this project; and
- (d) the economic, social and environmental impact of this project on Odisha?

(a) The Detailed Project Report (DPR) involving alignment study, feasibility study, pre-construction activities (including assessment of Land Acquisition) for development of Coastal Highway in the State of Odisha with tentative length of 408.435 km has been awarded.

(b) and (c) The award of civil construction work can be after the completion of DPR, statutory clearances and pre- construction activities depending upon projected traffic, techno - economic viability and inter-se-priority. It is premature to indicate the cost of project, completion time and families affected till the DPR is received.

(d) The economic, social and environmental impact of this project will be known after completion of DPR.
