- (a) the number of projects to be completed during the year 2024 under National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) Mission and the total cumulative number of projects to be completed by 2024;
- (b) the number of new projects sanctioned in 2024 under the said Mission and their financial cost;
- (c) the steps taken by Government for sewage treatment in the year 2024; and
- (d) the number of sewage treatment projects that have been taken up in Ganga basin since the launch of the said Mission?

(a) to (d) Under the National Mission for Clean Ganga, from January to December 2024, a total of 27 projects were completed, bringing the cumulative total to 305 Projects. Additionally, 39 projects have been sanctioned at a cost of ₹ 2,056 crore in 2024. For pollution abatement, 12 sewage treatment projects with a capacity of 203.55 Million Liter Per Day (MLD) have been approved in 2024 bringing the cumulative total of 206 sewage treatment projects with a capacity of 6,335 MLD, since the launch of the Namami Gange Programme.
