- (a) whether there is wide variation in Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 10 that calls for progressively reducing not only income inequalities but also inequalities of outcome by ensuring access to equal opportunities and promoting social, economic and political inclusion of all;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the corrective measures proposed to be taken by Government, keeping in view the fact that as per the SDG India Index, it is at far below the average?

- (a) & (b) According to the SDG India Index Report, 2023-24 released by NITI Aayog, SDG Index score for Goal 10 is estimated at 65 which is in the 'Front Runner' category (a score between 65–99). However, there is variation in scores across States and UTs, ranging from 43 to 87.
