- (c) the expected date of the new science and technology policy by the Union Government?

- (a) The State Governments of Kerala (1974 & 2002), Gujarat (2018), Himachal Pradesh (2021) and Madhya Pradesh (2022) have already implemented separate science policy in their respective States.
- (b) Kerala was the first state that implemented the science and technology policy after independence in 1974.
- (c) At present, no new science and technology policy is under consideration by the Union Government.
