EFFORTS MADE FOR PROMOTION OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN THE COUNTRY

114. SHRI ADITYA PRASAD:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of schemes/initiatives/programmes being undertaken by Government to promote entrepreneurship in the country, State-wise;
- (b) scheme-wise performance of each of the said schemes being implemented in the State of Jharkhand during the last five years and the current year;
- (c) the details of persons benefited from each of these schemes in the State of Jharkhand during the last five years and the current year, year-wise and district-wise; and
- (d) the details of the Central allocation and State Grants sanctioned, approved, released and spent during each of the last five years, scheme-wise and district-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES

(a): The Government has undertaken various schemes/initiatives/programmes to promote entrepreneurship across the Country. The details of the major schemes/programmes of the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) to promote entrepreneurship are as under:

1. Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP): PMEGP is a Central Sector Scheme that is implemented by the Ministry of MSME, through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) for assisting entrepreneurs in setting up of new enterprises in the non-farm sector. PMEGP Scheme assists General Category beneficiaries with Margin Money (MM) subsidy of 25% of the project cost in rural areas and 15% in urban areas. For beneficiaries belonging to Special Categories such as Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBCs, Minorities, Women etc., the Margin Money subsidy is 35% in rural areas and 25% in urban areas. The maximum cost of project is Rs. 50 lakhs in the manufacturing sector and Rs. 20 lakhs in the service sector. Since 2018-19, existing PMEGP/REGP/MUDRA enterprises are also supported based on past good performances with 2nd loan for upgradation and expansion.

2. Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programme (ESDP): ESDP is a Central Sector Scheme aimed at promoting new enterprises, capacity-building of existing MSMEs and inculcate entrepreneurial culture in the country through awareness programmes and managerial skill development programmes.

3. National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH): The Scheme aims at promoting entrepreneurship among the SC/ST population and to fulfil the 4% procurement mandate by the Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) as laid down in the Central Government Public Procurement Policy. Several initiatives have been taken under the Scheme to provide professional support to SCs-STs in skilling/capacity building, market linkages, finance facilitation, tender bid participation etc.
