Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which the changes introduced in the revised National Metadata Structure (NMDS) 2.0 aims at promoting transparency and understanding of datasets among stakeholders; and
- (b) the manner in which the Ministry will monitor the implementation of NMDS 2.0 and adherence to statistical standards across different Ministries, and details of the metrics that will be used to assess success?

(a) The National Metadata Structure (NMDS 2.0) is designed with the objective that data and information are uniformly represented, provide clarity on the data sources, collection methods and enhance discoverability of data sets. It is to bring in improved understanding of various data sets in public domain such as census, surveys, administrative and those from other sources.

(b) The NMDS 2.0 has been shared with Ministries/Departments for implementation. The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation regularly interacts with the Statistical Advisors of Ministries/Departments on various issues, including this.
