**BALANCED SOIL NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT AND ISSUANCE OF SOIL HEALTH CARD**

512. SMT. MAHUA MAJI:  
DR. BHIM SINGH:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has formulated a balanced nutrient management scheme under the recommendations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) to prevent the decline in soil quality, if so, the detail,s thereof;
- (b) whether Government has implemented a soil health and fertility scheme to assist State Governments in issuing soil health cards to farmers, if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) the number of soil health cards that have been generated so far and the benefits received by farmers in terms of improved soil quality, the details thereof, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE  
(SHRI RAMNATH THAKUR)

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir, the Government is implementing Soil Health & Fertility Scheme as a component of PM-Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (PM-RKVY) to provide Soil Health Cards for all farm holdings, to promote balanced and integrated nutrient management as per the recommendations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), to prevent the decline in soil quality. Under the Scheme, Soil Health Cards (SHCs) are issued to farmers that provide information on nutrient status of soil. Recommendations on judicious dosage and type of fertilizers for improving soil health and fertility are given. Soil samples are analysed for parameters such as pH, electrical conductivity, Organic Carbon, available Nitrogen, Phosphorus, Potassium, Sulphur, and micro-nutrients (Zinc, Copper, Iron, Manganese & Boron). There is also provision to set up static Soil Testing Labs, Mobile Soil Testing Labs, Mini Soil Testing Labs and Village Soil Testing Labs besides strengthening of existing laboratories to undertake soil testing.

Since 2014-15, 24.74 crore SHCs have been generated across the country as per Annexure.
