STEPS TO SUPPORT AND DEVELOP MSME UNITS IN TAMIL NADU

*71. SHRI R. DHARMAR:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that thousands of MSME units were shut down after 2020 and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the total MSME units registered within Tamil Nadu, as on date;
- (c) whether Government has taken any effective steps to support and develop MSME units in Tamil Nadu in particular under GST regime;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the total funds allocated in this regard; and
- (e) the various steps taken by Government to provide incentives and other encouragements to best performing MSME units in the country?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 71 FOR 10.02.2025 REGARDING "STEPS TO SUPPORT AND DEVELOP MSME UNITS IN TAMIL NADU".

(a): As per the Udyam Registration and Udyam Assist portals, total number of MSMEs registered are 5.91 crore till date. Out of this, the number of MSMEs which de-registered due to shutdown are 71,493. The details are as follows:

(b): The total number of MSME units, including Informal Micro Enterprises, registered in the State of Tamil Nadu as on date is 48,11,962.

(c) and (d): Government, through various schemes, programmes and policy initiatives, supports the development of MSMEs in the country, under GST regime, including the State of Tamil Nadu. Government's schemes/programmes inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGS) for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs), Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme (ESDP), Procurement and Marketing Support Scheme (PMSS), International Cooperation scheme, Tool Rooms, Technology Centre System Programme, National SC/ST Hub (NSSH), MSME Champions, etc.

MSMEs are benefitted through assessment on different parameters in Bronze, Silver and Gold certification levels. The details of Bronze, Silver and Gold certification under ZED in the country vis-a-vis the State of Tamil Nadu are as given below:
