CITIES DEVELOPED UNDER URBAN BASIC SERVICES PROGRAMME FOR POOR

682. DR. M. THAMBIDURAI:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of cities developed under Urban Basic Services Programme for the poor in the country, State-wise including the State of Tamil Nadu;
- (b) the quantum of funds allocated for this purpose and spent on these, during the last three years and the current year till date, State-wise, city-wise; and
- (c) the details of the works undertaken along with the achievements made in this regard, city-wise, State-wise?

- (a) to (c): Government of India launched Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) in December, 2005 for assisting States/Urban Territories (UTs) by extending Central Assistance for providing houses and related civic amenities to urban poor including slum dwellers in 65 select cities under Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) and in other cities/towns under Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) including cities/towns of Tamil Nadu. The period of JnNURM was upto March, 2012. However, to complete the on-going projects sanctioned upto 31.03.2012, the period was extended and funds were released upto March 2017. Since scheme has ended, no funds were released during the last three years and the current year. The State/UT wise and city wise details of physical and financial progress under BSUP component of JnNURM in the country is at Annexure.
