FOOD TESTING LABORATORIES IN CHHATTISGARH

567. SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA:

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of food testing laboratories in Chhattisgarh receiving grants from the Ministry till date, district-wise;
- (b) the total amount of funds disbursed under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) for food testing laboratories since 2019, State-wise, including the State of Chhattisgarh; and
- (c) the way the Government would recover the unutilized grants disbursed under PMKSY?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES
(SHRI RAVNEET SINGH)

(a): Under the Scheme of Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure, no entity in Chhattisgarh has received grant from the Ministry for setting up/Upgradation of Food Testing Laboratories.

(b): The State-wise details of amount of funds disbursed for Setting Up/Upgradation of Food Testing Laboratories, under Scheme of Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure a component of Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) since 2019, are at Annexure.

(c): As per the existing Scheme Guidelines, the grant is released on reimbursement basis in instalments only after the Project Implementing Agency (PIA) has incurred the required expenditure. In cases where projects are not completed after receiving partial grant from the Ministry, besides taking action to terminate the project following due process, the Ministry also takes recourse to legal action to recover the amount in consultation with Department of Legal Affairs.
