PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF OIL REFINERIES

771. SHRI G.C. CHANDRASHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the existing capacity of refineries in the public sector;
- (b) whether the public sector oil companies have prepared any action plan to increase refining capacity of their refineries;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the augmentation of refining capacity of public sector oil undertakings has helped increase in export earnings; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) The refinery capacity of public sector refineries in India is 158.6 Million Metric Tonne Per Annum (MMTPA).

(b) & (c) Yes. The refining capacity of the public sector oil refineries is projected to increase to 210.00 MMTPA by 2030.

(d) & (e) During the period from 2021-22 to 2023-24, augmentation of public sector oil refineries capacity has enabled increase in export earnings on petroleum products from Rs.76775 Crs. to Rs. 79154 Crs.
