WI-FI FACILITIES AT RAILWAY STATIONS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of railway stations having Wi-Fi facility provided by Government;
- (b) if so, the details of stations including Karnataka and stations located within border area of Bihar, State-wise;
- (c) the average speed of internet available to passengers at such stations; and
- (d) the average number of passengers using this facility per day?

(a) to (d): A total of 6112 railway stations have been provided with Wi-Fi facility including 335 stations of Karnataka and 393 stations of Bihar.

Besides the above, almost all railway stations on Indian Railways network have 4G/5G coverage provided by the Telecom Service Providers which is being utilised by passengers for data connectivity resulting in enhanced passenger experience.
