Development of AYUSH infrastructure in Odisha

812 Shri Manas Ranjan Mangaraj:

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of AYUSH hospitals and wellness centres currently operational in Odisha;
- (b) whether there are any proposals to establish new AYUSH facilities in the State;
- (c) if so, the details of these proposals, including locations and timelines; and
- (d) the funds allocated and utilized for the development of AYUSH infrastructure in Odisha during the last five years?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH

(a) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), Ministry of Ayush has sanctioned 3 Integrated Ayush Hospitals and 422 AYUSH Health and Wellness Centres [now known as Ayushman Arogya Mandir (Ayush)] and in Odisha for operationalization by upgrading the existing Ayush dispensaries, as per the proposals received from the State Government through State Annual Action Plan (SAAPs). As reported by the State Government of Odisha all 422 AAM (Ayush) are functional however, no any approved hospital is reported functional by the State Government.

(b) to (d) Public Health being a State subject, establishment of new Ayush facilities in the country including Odisha comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under NAM, there is a provision of financial assistance to State/UT Governments for setting up of 50 /30 /10 bedded integrated AYUSH hospitals in the country. Accordingly, as per the proposals received through SAAPs, 3 units of integrated Ayush Hospitals have been approved to Odisha at Dhenkenal, Behrampore and Balasore in year 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2019-20 respectively. As per the proposals received from the State/UT Governments during the last 5 years, Ministry of Ayush has released an amount of Rs. 4161.23 lakhs for implementation of different approved activities under NAM
