DOCTORS AND PARAMEDICAL STAFF IN AIIMS HOSPITALS

896. SHRI SANDEEP KUMAR PATHAK:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of sanctioned posts and vacant posts of doctors and paramedical staff in all operational AIIMS hospitals, the details thereof hospital-wise and department-wise;
- (b) the number of doctors and paramedical staff appointed in each AIIMS hospital during the last three years, year-wise, hospital-wise and department-wise along with the reasons for posts being remained vacant; and
- (c) the year by which the vacant posts will be filled, the details thereof hospital-wise and department-wise?

(a) to (c): Creation of posts and recruitment is a continuous process. The details of sanctioned, filled and vacant faculty and non-faculty positions in various All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), during the last three years, are placed at Annexure.

Filling up of positions is dependent on availability of doctors and health care professionals in particular stream, applications received against advertisements issued, location of the institutes, reservation roster, resignations tendered etc. In order to expeditiously fill vacant sanctioned positions in various AIIMS, following steps have been taken by the Government:

- (i) Centralized Nursing Officer Recruitment Common Eligibility Test (NORCET) is conducted by AIIMS Delhi for recruitment of Nursing Officers in various AIIMS.
- (ii) Common Recruitment Examination (CRE) is conducted by AIIMS Delhi for facilitating recruitment for Group B and C non-faculty vacancies across AIIMS.

(iii) Institute of National Importance Combined Entrance Test (INI-CET) and Institute of National Importance Super Speciality (INI-SS) exam is conducted by AIIMS Delhi to select Junior Residents (Academic) and Senior Residents (Academic) for various AIIMS.
