**AIIMS LIKE INSTITUTIONS IN VARIOUS STATES**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:-

- (a) the current status of new and proposed AIIMS like institutions in various States in last five years;
- (b) whether Government has revisited the criterion and formulae for the selection of sites for establishing AIIMS-like institutions, if so, the current criteria and formulae for the establishment of AIIMS;
- (c) whether Government has considered the establishment of an AIIMS in Silchar (Assam), given its geographical spread and population density as recommended by the Parliamentary Standing Committee in 2022, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons for not considering the same?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) aims to correct regional imbalances in the availability of affordable/ reliable tertiary healthcare services and also to augment facilities for quality medical education in the country. Under PMSSY, till date establishment of 22 All India Institutes of Medical Sciences(AIIMS) has been approved in various States/UTs in the country including one AIIMS at Guwahati in Assam. Details of AIIMS, State-wise is placed at **Annexure**. Under PMSSY, AIIMS are set up in different parts of the country in a phased manner, keeping in view the gaps in availability of tertiary healthcare facilities. In current phase of PMSSY, there is no proposal for establishment of a new AIIMS in Silchar.

Under another component of PMSSY scheme, up-gradation of Guwahati Medical College and Assam Medical College has been undertaken on Centre-State cost sharing

basis by way of setting up super-specialty facilities. The Super Speciality Block (SSB) of Guwahati Medical College consists of 244 beds (including 60 ICU beds) and 6 Departments, viz. Paediatric Surgery, Burns & Plastic Surgery, Gastroenterology, Gastrosurgery, Hematology and Endocrinology with 6 OTs. The SSB of Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh consists of 265 beds (including 64 ICU beds and 12 dialysis beds) and 6 Departments, viz. Urology, Cardiology, CTVS, Neurology, Neurosurgery, and Pediatric Surgery with 5 OTs.
