**HOUSEHOLDS BENEFITED UNDER PM SURYA GHAR: MUFT BIJLI YOJANA**

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of households benefited so far under PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana;
- (b) the details of applications received so far under this scheme, State-wise, especially the details of applications received from the State of Rajasthan and the benefited households;
- (c) the number of households targeted by Government to install solar plants in the financial year 2024-25; and
- (d) the details of subsidy provided under this scheme, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) As on March 1, 2025, a total of 47.06 lakh applications have been registered and over 9.70 lakh households have been benefited through installation of rooftop solar plants under the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSG: MBY).

The State/UT wise detail of applications received, households benefitted, including of the state of Rajasthan, under PMSG: MBY is given in **Annexure**.

(c) It was estimated that during the initial year i.e. FY 2024-25, of the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, a total of 12 lakh households are likely to be benefitted through the installation of solar rooftop plants under the scheme.

(d) The State/UT wise detail of CFA released under PMSG: MBY is given in **Annexure**.
