(a) to (c): Government of India has issued Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order, 2017, as amended on 19.07.2024, to encourage Make in India and promote manufacturing and production of goods and services in India with a view to enhancing income and employment. In compliance, the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals has issued the Public Procurement Orders for chemicals sector from time to time. The details of State-wise total procurement made under the Make in India Programme by various Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)/Autonomous Bodies under Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers during the last three years are given at **Annexure**.
