(a): The details of CSR works carried out by Coal India Limited (CIL) HQ, Kolkata in the districts of operations of Central Coalfields Limited (CCL) and Bharat Coking Coal Limited (BCCL) along with the means used for the said purpose during the last three financial years are as under:-

(b): The number of displaced persons rehabilitated by CCL & BCCL are 649 and 99 respectively in the last two years. In addition, during the same period, 274 BCCL families and 168 Non-Legal Title Holder (N LTH) families have been rehabilitated by BCCL and Jharia Rehabilitation and Development Authority (JRDA) respectively.
