acquisition of 10 medium capacity long-range (A-340-300) and 18 small Capacity short-range (B-737-800) aircraft at an estimated cost of Rs. 10,589 crores. The Project Report relating to this proposal has not yet been received by the Government.

Accidents involving private airlines

- 1414. SHRI G.K. VASAN: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:
- (a) the details of accidents involving aircrafts run by private operations; and
- (b) the action taken against such operators for not taking safety measures?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDI): (a) There had been 11 accidents to Indian Civil Registered Aircraft belonging to private operators from 01.01.2001 to 30.11.2003.
