Winding up of offices of GIC

1420. SHRI_G.K. VASAN: Will the Minister of FINANCE_be pleased to state:

- (a) whether GIC has wound up its Asset Management Company's Offices in Delhi and a few other cities; and
 - (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI ANANDRAO VITHOBA ADSUL): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) The branches of GIC's Asset Management Company (AMC) located at New Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai, Hyderabad, Ahmedabad, Chandigarh, Patna, Pune, Bangalore and Bhubaneshwar were closed in a phased manner between May, 2000 and July, 2003. The reasons for closure of branches of the offices of AMC are as under:
 - (i) Decline in asset base under management over the period.
 - (ii) Fall in the mobilization of open-ended schemes.
- (iii) Availability of services of Registrar and Transfer Agents to attend to the investor services at various Centres lieu of Branches.
