#### Utilization of sports promotion and development funds

2004. SHRI DARA SINGH: Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) the allocation of funds for promotion and development of sports activities by Government during last three years, State-wise;

(b) what is the ratio of utilization of sports grants particularly in Maharashtra and Punjab as compared to other States in the country during that period, State-wise; and

(c) what measures have been taken by Government to ensure proper utilization of funds by States given for development and promotion of sports culture in the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI VIJAY GOEL): (a) and (b) Depending upon the receipt of viable proposals from the State Governments under the schemes of (i) Grants for Creation of Sports Infrastructure; and (ii) Scheme of Promotion of Sports and Games in Schools, admissible Central assistance is provided to the States. State-wise details of grants released including Maharashtra and Punjab during the last three years *i.e.* from 2000-01 to 2002-03 under the aforementioned schemes have been indicated in the enclosed Statements I and II respectively. (See below)

(c) To ensure proper utilization of funds by the States, Utilization Certificates are invariably obtained of the grant already released before released of further grants in considered.
