

Deaths of tribals by snake bites

†1623. SHRI JANESHWAR MISHRA: Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that during rainy season due to non-availability of resources, a large number of tribals die because of snake biting and biting by the poisonous species;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether it is also a fact that no efforts have been made by Government for their livelihood; and

(d) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI F.S. KULASTE): (a) No such incidents have been reported to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. Also, such information is not being maintained centrally.
