**Database of diseases**

1530. SHRI EKANATH K. THAKUR: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have plan to undertake annual surveys across the country to access data on the treatment of diseases

such as diabetes, coronary artery disease, cancer, mental health and hypertension;

(b) if so, how this data bank would help Government in taking policy decisions; and

(c) the States where this pilot project would be undertaken?

**THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRIMATI SUSHMA SWARAJ):** (a) to (c) At present, no annual surveys are undertaken to access data on the treatment of diseases such as diabetes, coronary artery disease, mental health and hypertension etc. As regards cancer, ICMR under its National Cancer Registry Programme (NCRP) collects and analyses data periodically through the hospital and population based cancer registries.

However, during the Tenth Five Year Plan, there is a proposal under integrated disease surveillance project to create sentinel centres for communicable and non-communicable diseases which will strengthen the existing surveillance system at the District, State and National level.
