**Dal Lake as a heritage site**

1762. PROF. SAIF-UD-DIN SOZ: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Dal Lake in Srinagar is part of a precious cultural heritage; and

(b) if so, whether Government propose to declare it as a heritage site and organise its conservation?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI JAGMOHAN): (a) Dal Lake in Srinagar has not been declared as a monument of national importance under the provisions of section 4 of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1958.

**Central assistance for tourism projects in Gujarat**

Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government of Gujarat has submitted three proposals for sanction of Central assistance for tourism projects;

(b) if so, the status thereof; and

(c) by when the Central assistance for these tourism projects will be sanctioned?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI JAGMOHAN): (a) The following proposals for development of tourism in the State of Gujarat were received in March, 2003:—

1. Development of vicinity of Sun Temple at Modhera, Distt. Mehsana
2. Infrastructure and Destination development at Nana Laija Distt. Kutch
3. Development of Heritage Village at Tera, Distt. Kutch

(b) Under the guidelines of the approved schemes of the Deptt. of Tourism, Govt. of India, one destination is taken up for development in each State every year. Govt. of Gujarat has been requested to indicate the order of priority for the execution of the projects.

(c) Central financial assistance is provided on the basis of the merits of the project, *inter se* priority and availability of funds.

### **Maintenance of Taj Mahal**

- (a) whether it is a fact that Taj has lost its beauty and lustre;
