Pending housing project of Andhra Pradesh

2375. SHRIMATI N. P. DURGA: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Government of Andhra Pradesh has submitted a project report for sanctioning 16,812 houses, which is pending before Government for sanction; and

(b) if so, the action contemplated by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI PON RADHAKRISHNAN): (a) and (b) No, Sir. However, as reported by HUDCO, the Government of Andhra Pradesh had submitted various proposals for construction of 16812 dwelling units to HUDCO; out of which, the proposals for 11061 houses could not be considered since those were not in accordance with the prescribed guidelines. The balance proposal for construction of 5751 dwelling units, complete in all respects, has been forwarded by HUDCO to the Government for approval.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI PON RADHAKRISHNAN): (a) Under the Integrated Development of Small & Medium Towns (IDSMT) Scheme, 114 new towns during the year 2001 - 02 and 168 new town during the 2002-03 were covered. The State-wise details of .these towns are placed at Statement I and II. (*See below*)

(b) During the year 2003-04, 78 new towns have been covered so far. The details of these towns is at Statement-III. (*See below*) Further coverage of towns in 2003-04 will depend upon the availability of funds and the submission of Project reports duly approved by State Level Sanctioning Committee.

(c) The ratio of State and the Centre for category A, B and C towns is as under:
