As per the information available, during the year 2002, 36 gardens spread over the States of Kerala, West Bengal, Assam, and Tripura were closed down due to financial crisis, resulting in unemployment among the workers of these gardens. State-wise details of the tea gardens closed and the number of workers affected are as follows:
