

(c) The States have been advised to be ready to introduce Smart Cards in road transport sector.

(d) Introduction of Smart Card-based registration certificates and driving license in road transport sector will enhance efficiency at RTO level and ensure that the documents are readable throughout the country. This would help in eliminating delay/harassment to citizens in inter-state movement and also in minimising the chances of use of fake/fraudulent documents.

(e) Several States have reportedly initiated preparatory steps, but none has yet fully introduced the scheme.

Completion of National Expressway
