THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. SANJAY PASWAN): (a) and (b) The initiatives of the government to spread literacy and education in the country include:

The Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan with the following objectives:

- All children in school, Education Guarantee Centre, Alternate School/Back to School' camp by 2003.
- All children complete five years of primary schooling by 2007.
- All children complete eight years of elementary schooling by 2010.
- Focus on elementary education of satisfactory quality with emphasis on education for life.
- Bridge all gender and social category gaps at primary stage by 2007 and at elementary education level by 2010.
- Universal retention by 2010.

The adult literacy schemes of the National Literacy Mission which provide functional literacy to non literates in the age group of 15-35 years. While basic literacy is imparted under Total Literacy Campaigns and Post Literacy Programmes, life long learning opportunities are provided under the Continuing Education Programme.
